All entries must use the official ASCA entry form with the agreement. Incorrect or missing information (including signature) will invalidate entries. Please use one entry form per dog.

RALLY CLASSES OFFERED: Masters C/B/A, Excellent C/B/A, Advanced C/B/A, Novice C/B/A

<u>OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED</u>: Utility B/A, Open ODX B/A, Open CDX B/A, Novice B/A & Beginner Novice B/A. Group Sits and Downs to follow individual levels of classes (B & A groups may be combined). WILDCARD CLASSES offered for all classes (see below for more information).

<u>Awards</u>: Rally: Ribbons for $1^{st} - 4^{th}$; Q ribbons for score 170 or over; X ribbons for scores 195 or over; Awards for High in Trial, High Combined, High Scoring Junior

Obedience: Ribbons for 1st - 4th; Q ribbons for scores 170 or over; Awards for High in Trial, High Combined, High Scoring Junior

<u>Additional Information</u>: Wildcard classes can be entered in addition to or in lieu of any regular obedience classes. The level entered in Wildcard can be higher than the dog's current title/level. For example, if a dog does NOT have an ASCA CD but is ready for Utility, the dog can enter the Wildcard Utility classes. All exercises can be performed or an exercise can be omitted. The Wildcard classes will be held after the beginning novice classes for each trial.

Additional Information:

- 1. Entry must be on CURRENT entry forms which can be found on the ASCA website (www.asca.org). Obedience entry form: https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/obedentryform.pdf Rally entry form: https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/rallyentryform.pdf
- 2. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Obedience and/or Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in obedience or rally.
- 4. No entry fees will be refunded after the close of pre-entries. Make checks payable to CVASC and mail to Ann McCabe. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$35 service charge for returned checks.
- 5. If the trials fill, a waiting list will be maintained and exhibitors will be notified if space becomes available.
- 6. These trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.
- 7. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS and keep your dog on a leash when not competing.
- 8. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- 9. Rally and Obedience are open to all breeds, including mixed breeds, with an ASCA Registration or ASCA QTracking number. We will have forms available at the trial (we will forward them to the ASCA office) but encourage you to apply for a QTracking number beforehand. - 10. CVASC, their Board of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owner assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.
- 11. Show Grounds: The show grounds are the boundaries of the grounds on which ASCA events are being held. They include, but not limited to, all areas outside the ring/trial arena (including the buffer zone) set aside for grooming, holding of dogs, and parking of vehicles of the exhibitor.

COVID-19 INFORMATION

- Masks will be required in accordance with state, county, and/or city ordinance, whichever is strictest. In the event the prevailing ordinance does not require masks to be worn, exhibitors will be required to wear masks while in the ring if required by the conformation judge.
- No masks will be provided to exhibitors or spectators. You must bring your own mask / face covering.
- Exhibitors will be required to read and sign a waiver in order to pick up arm band numbers or enter the ring.
- Everyone in attendance will be expected to maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet both in and out of the show ring. Individual set ups must be spaced a minimum of 6 feet apart.
- Spectators or individuals not directly involved in the showing of dogs each day should be kept to a minimum.
- All entries forms must be completed prior to coming to the entry table. CVASC will provide extra
 entry forms at a table located away from the entry secretary, but will not provide any pens. Please
 ensure you bring pen if entries need to be completed at the show.
- All exhibitors and spectators are expected to act in a responsible manner with regard to social
 distancing, sanitizing of hands, and wearing appropriate face covering as outlined above. While hand
 sanitizer will be provided by CVASC for judges, stewards, and volunteers, all exhibitors and
 spectators should bring their own hand sanitizer in the event extra is not available.

Central Valley ASC reserves the right to request anyone behaving in a reckless or inconsiderate manner with respect to COVID-19 protocols to leave the grounds. If this becomes necessary, no refund of entries will be made.
